STEPHAN BALKENHOL

Stephan Balkenhol was born in 1957 in Fritzlar (Hesse) in Germany. Today he lives and works between Karlsruhe, Germany and Meisenthal, France.

Attending the Hamburg School of Fine Arts from 1976 - 82, Balkenhol was exposed to the Minimalist and Conceptual trends popular at that time, with tutors including Nam June Paik and Sigmar Polke. His experience here profoundly affected his subsequent artistic practice. Sensing an absence in these two schools of thought, Balkenhol sought out the human figure and began a considered campaign to reintroduce it into contemporary art, declaring: "I must reinvent the figure to resume an interrupted tradition".

As a renowned sculptor, Balkenhol is recognised not only for the technical prowess with which he hand carves each of his wooden sculptures, but for his continual devotion to exploring the role of the figure within contemporary art. The artist's unique sculptures combine anonymous human figures with tall pedestals, all hand carved from singular blocks, often of poplar or wawa wood. The figures emanate timelessness: simple, plain-coloured clothing and the confident yet unassuming poses of the everyday man.

Balkenhol has developed a significant repertoire of public commissions spanning his twenty-year career, with installations in front of the Blackfriars Bridge in London, at the entrance of the Hamburg Zoo; at the Städelsches Kunstinstitut in Frankfurt; and in Kassel and Leipzig, Germany.

Balkenhol was recently the subject of a major solo exhibition at the Landes Museum, Linz, Austria (2015-2014). Notable solo exhibitions include; 'Stephan Balkenhol', Kunstmuseum Ravensburg, Germany (2014); 'Stephan Balkenhol', 'Unlimited Bodies - Corps Sans Limite,' Palais d'léna, Paris, France (2012); 'Stephan Balkenhol,' Musée de Grenoble, Grenoble (2010); 'Stephan Balkenhol,' Deichtorhallen, Hamburg (2008-2009); 'Stephan Balkenhol,' Staatliche Kunsthalle, Baden-Baden (2006); 'Stephan Balkenhol,' National Museum of Contemporary Art, Osaka (2005); 'Stephan Balkenhol,' Tel Aviv Museum of Art, Tel Aviv (2005); Sprengel Museum, Hannover (2003); Hirshhorn Museum and Sculpture Garden, Washington DC (1995); The Irish Museum of Modern Art, Dublin (1991).

Balkenhol's works are included in prominent collections internationally, including the Musée des Beaux Arts de Montréal, Quebec; Smithsonian Institution, Hirshhorn Museum and Sculpture Garden, Washington DC; Art Institute of Chicago, Chicago; Hamburger Bahnhof, Berlin; Kunstmuseum Bonn, Germany; Musée de Grenoble, France; The National Museum of Art, Osaka and Peggy Guggenheim Collection

HANEFI YETER

HANEFİ YETER (1947)

Hanefi Yeter started his education in the Workshop of Bedri Rahmi Eyüboğlu of the State Academy of Fine Arts in 1967 and studied in Bedri Rahmi Eyüpoğlu's Private Workshop during his training. In 1970, he earned the right to receive art training in Paris, "Academie des Beaux-Arts", because of some personal reasons he couldn't finished his education and turned back to Istanbul. He completed his education at the Academy and graduated from there in 1972. In 1973 he passed the State Scholarship Examination and started his postgraduate studies in Berlin, the Fine Arts Academy, and graduated in 1978.

Events Abroad


Yeter opened nearly 56 personal exhibitions abroad in Vienna, Paris, Brussels, Manchester City and various cities in Germany. He became the first turkish-born who opened a personal exhibition in East Germany. In that exhibition his catalogue was published with special permissions. He took place in numerous group exhibitions, books, catalogues, posters and different countries' media outlets.

The book "Hanefi Yeter 1962-1982" written by Volker Martin was published in 1982. His various works are in the Museum of Berlin.

He performed 5 murals, 2 ceramic facades, 2 mosaic panels, 1 sculpture in Berlin and 3 murals in the city Darmstadt.

He had 28 personal exhibitions in his domestic. Two books of Yeter were published which contain his paintings and sculptures.

Between the dates 2006 and 2012 he performed up to 100 sculptures and reliefs in the shopping malls Forum Mersin, Aydin, Denizli, Trabzon, Ankara, Bursa, Istanbul, Antalya, Tarsus and Nevşehir.

HERBERT MEHLE

HERBERT MEHLER

Herbert Mehler (* 1949 in Steinau) is a German sculptor.

Mehler gained his first artistic experience with his father, a wood sculptor Franz Mehler.

Following his training as a sculptor, he studied from 1972-1976 painting at the Academy of Fine Arts in Nuremberg.

Together with his wife, the painter Sonja Noble of Hoeßle, he founded in 2000 on an old farm in the Würzburg region the "reed home project" in order to concentrate on his art can.

Works by Herbert Mehler and were exhibited in numerous museums, galleries and public spaces, including the Castle Museum Aschaffenburg (1989), in the Artothek Nuremberg (1990), in the Artothek Krefeld (1998), "Conventino II" in the Municipal Collections Schweinfurt (2000), the Water and Shipping Authority Schweinfurt, at the Centro per l'Arte Contemporanea Monteciccardo / Italy (2003), the Museum of the Cathedral and the Museum in the cultural memory of Würzburg (2006) and the Federal Institute for Occupational Nuremberg, the State Insurance Office of Lower Franconia and Baden steelworks Kehl.

Since January 2008, six pieces from the series "Kavex" in Berlin can be seen on the grounds of the hospital Elisabeth Herzberge.

Since July 2009, stands at the so-called "bank sculptures" in the Old Port of Würzburg the 7.20 m high sculpture "BELLADONNA" Mehler.

Herbert Mehler lives and works in Berlin and Riedheim, besides sculptures he produces special drawings using chalk and charcoal on cardboard.
